Ashill is bringing forward proposals for up to 66 high-quality homes on land south of 131 to 147 Burwood Road, Hersham.

The site sits on Hersham's south-western edge near Walton-on-Thames. It is bordered by housing to the east and north and a cemetery on Turners Lane to the west.

With a new housing target of over 1,500 homes per year, an increase in delivery by over 200%, Elmbridge Borough Council has a significant need for new homes that meet the aspirations of local people. With over 2,000 applications for social housing in 2022 alone and the average waiting time for a 4-bedroom property being many years, Elmbridge Borough Council has a significant unmet need for new homes – especially affordable and family-sized homes.

Recognising the need for more affordable homes in Elmbridge, Ashill is providing 50% affordable homes on the site. Of the 66 homes proposed, 42 will be family houses with gardens and the site will also provide a new public woodland walk with a significant proportion of the site as green public open space as well as financial contributions to local infrastructure.

We are committed to engaging with the local community and are pleased to invite you to take part in a public consultation on our proposals, which will run from Wednesday 10 December to Saturday 10 January 2026.

Creation of a thoughtfully landscaped development of 66 new homes, of which 42 will be family houses with gardens.



Retention and enhancement of trees and hedgerows around site boundaries and planting new soft vegetation like shrubs and wildflowers, contributing to a biodiversity net gain of at least 10%.



A mix of 1, 2, 3 and 4 bed homes to meet local demand. 50%, 33 in total, will be affordable.



A new woodland walk and a large proportion of the site landscaped to be public green open space.



New pedestrian links to the site to the north and west enhancing local pedestrian connectivity.
