## **Roads Included in Survey:**

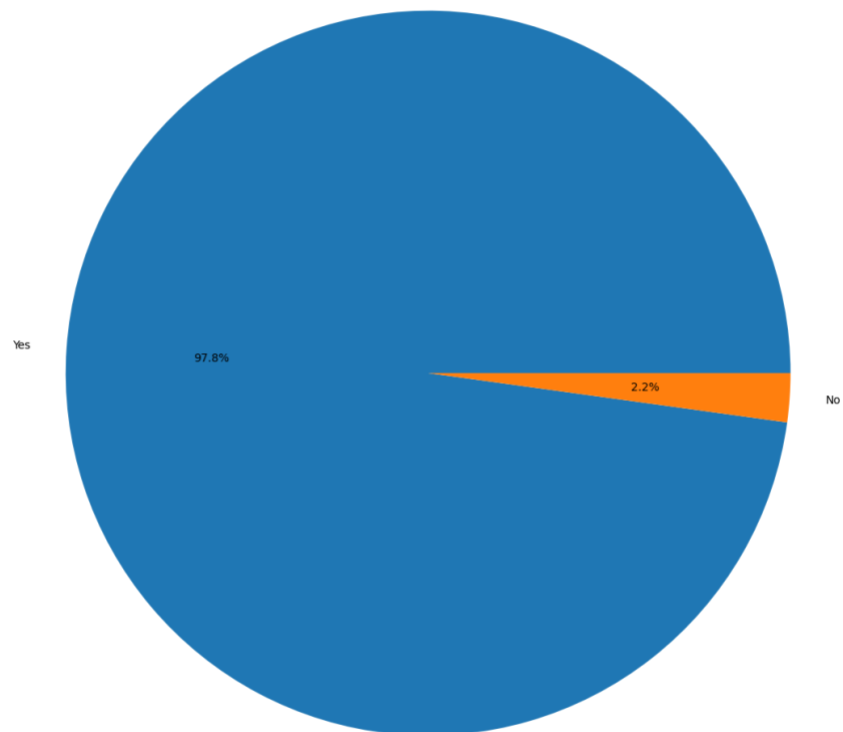

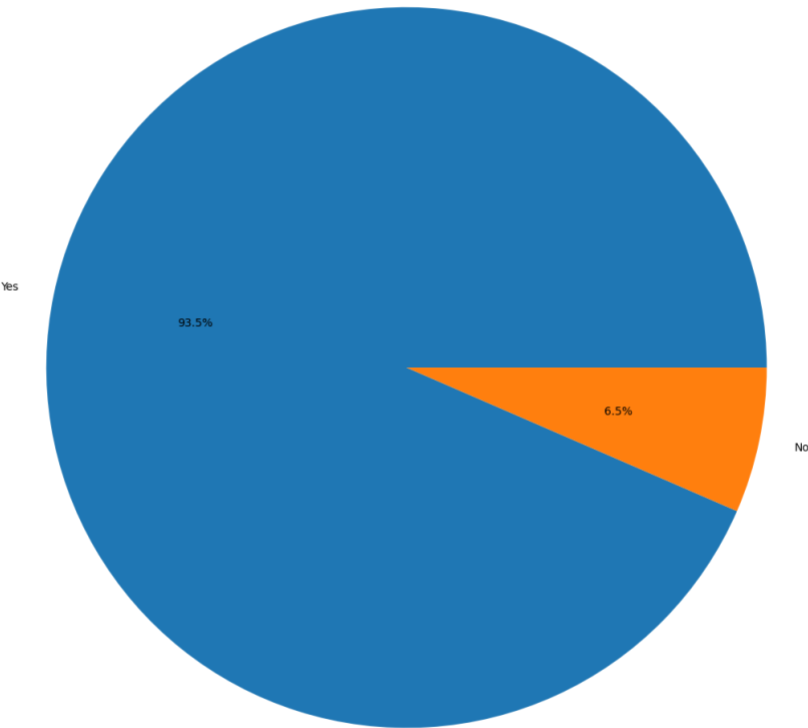
**Question 1: Do you support introducing a 20mph speed limit on Burwood Road? 45 out of 46 respondents said “Yes”**

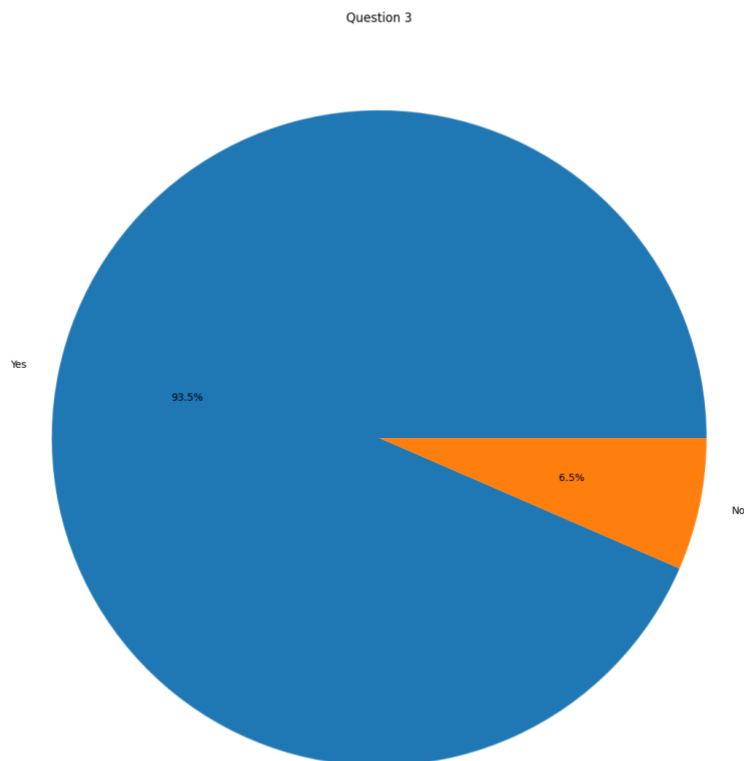
**Question 2: Do you support introducing a 20mph speed limit on Queens Road? 43 respondents said “yes”, 3 said “no”**

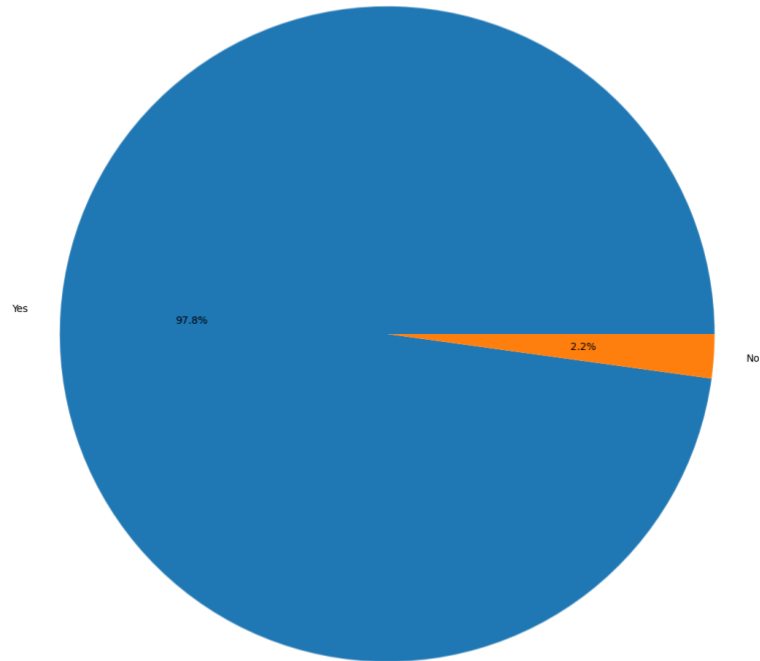
**Question 3: Do you support introducing a 20mph speed limit on Molesey Road (from the Waterman's Arms towards Lidl)?**

43 respondents said "yes", 3 said "no"



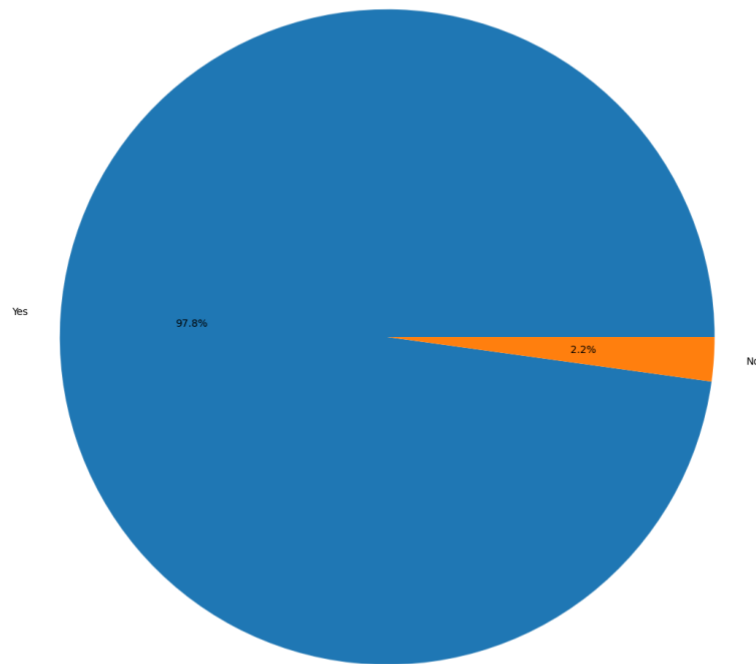
**Question 4: Do you support introducing a 20mph speed limit on Faulkners Road? 45 respondents said “yes”, 1 said “no”.**

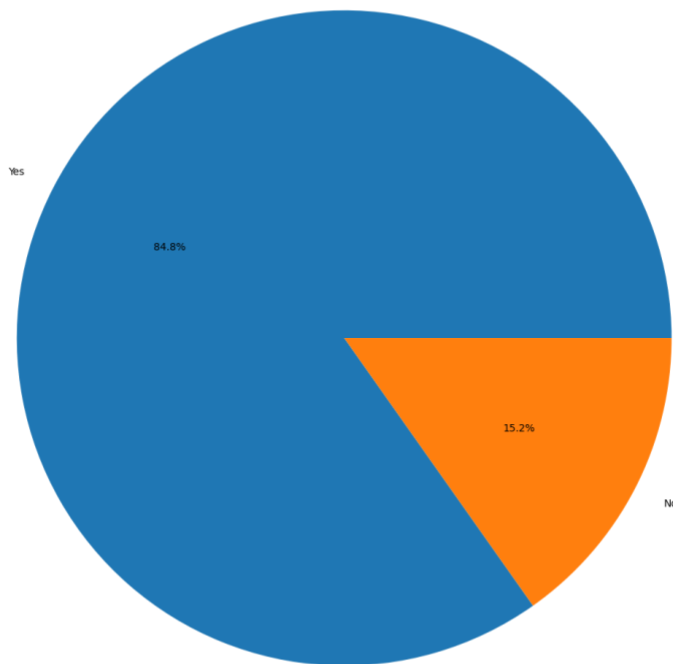
**Question 5: Do you believe vehicle speeds are currently too high on Burwood Road?** 45 respondents said “yes”, 1 said “no” (not aware).

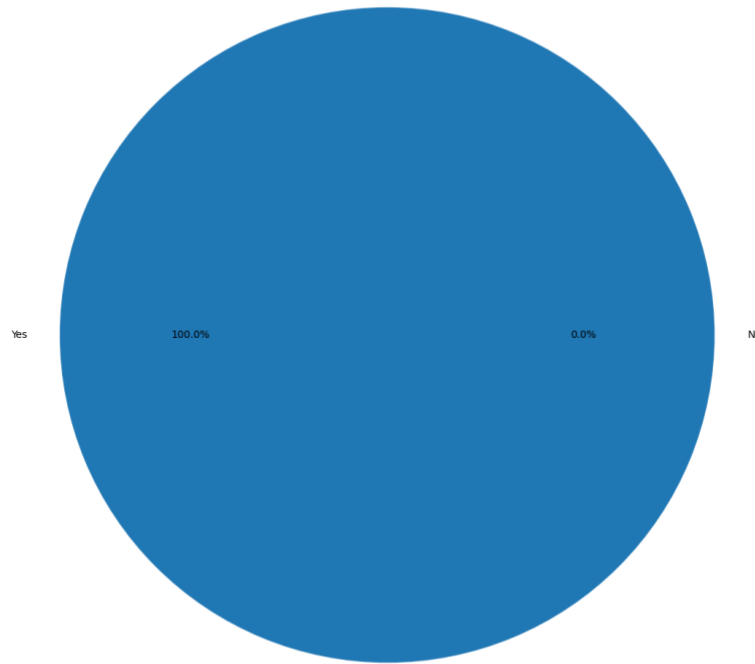

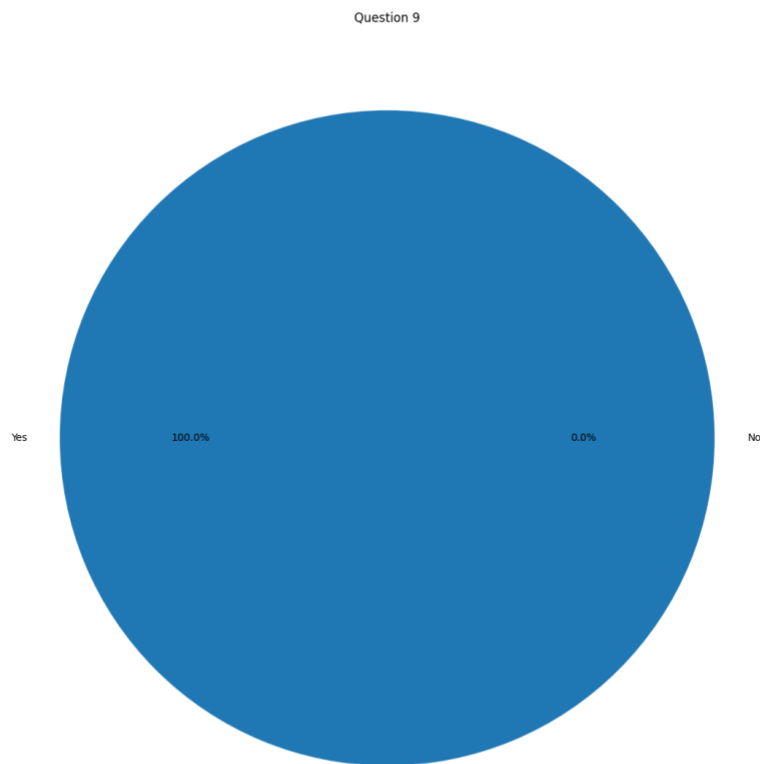


**Question 8: Do you believe a 20mph limit would improve pedestrian safety in Hersham Village centre? All 46 respondents said "Yes".**

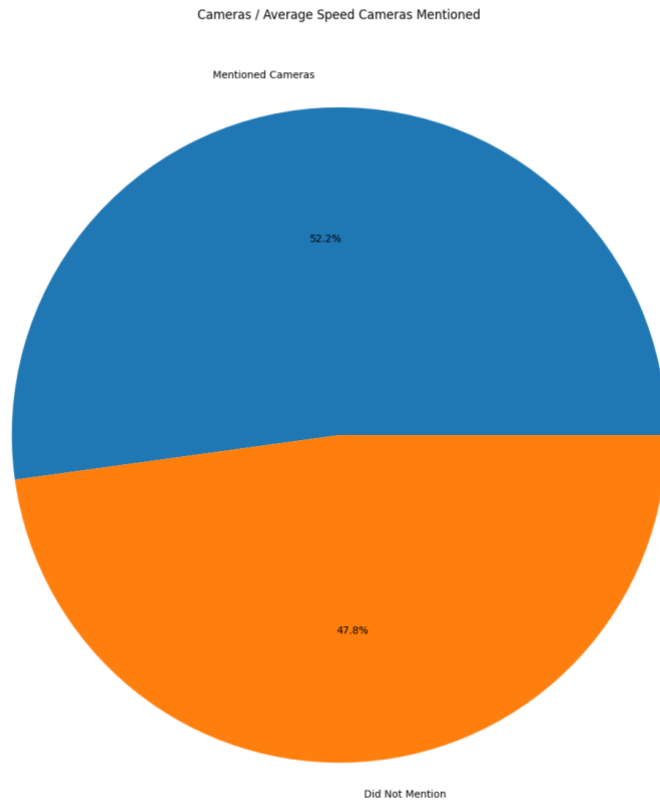

**Other Comments: 24 respondents specifically mentioned Average Speed Cameras / Speed Cameras in their feedback.**  
**Consider:** Just because respondents did not mention it, that does not mean they do not want them - with some saying “anything to slow down cars”.



**Other Comments:** Perception of speed of local roads - all 46 respondents (100%) recognise that speeding is an issue in the local area, particularly on Burwood Road.
